

Ethiopia Project

Sutton is pleased to have been awarded a contract by YMG Gold in Ethiopia to assist with the management of their project in South-West Ethiopia, near the town of Shakiso.











Sutton has deployed a number of professional personnel to the site to assist with the management of the project, commissioning of the gravity gold processing plant, build and commission a tailings storage facility (TSF) and to re-evaluate the mining methods, procedures and operations.

The gold processing plant was supplied by the South African OEM, Appropriate Processing Technologies (APT) and is currently being commissioned at the Shakiso process site. The plant consists of a number of different circuits being, washing and scrubbing, Crushing and Milling utilising primary and secondary crushers and a ball mill, Gravity recovery using the automated GKX centrifugal concentrators and final clean-up and smelting.

Sutton is also re-commissioning YMG's smaller plant near the Hiyadima pit, to reduce the pressure on haulage and increase the company's production capacity.

Mining methods and procedures are being re-evaluated with the aim of commencing sustainable mining operations in the coming 3 months.

YMG is significantly invested in the community and is launching several initiatives to engage and significantly contribute to the regional economy. Sutton is proud to be associated with YMG and its principals and is committed to contributing to the future success of the company and its existing and upcoming projects.
